**Requirements**

- Ability to lift 50 lbs
- Comfortable working in all weather conditions
- Work 5 days a week (Monday-Friday); 8-9 hours per day.
- At least 18 years old
- Able to work well with others.
- Comfortable working with kids between ages 7-12
- Ability to manage time when leading activities.
- Pass a Background Check
- First-Aid and CPR Certification (or willingness to obtain)\*\*

*\*\*If you do not have your First Aid and CPR Certification, we will be including a fully funded certification course within the 2-week training period prior to camp starting.\*\**

Candidates should be flexible, friendly, and comfortable working in a variety of conditions. A successful candidate will have excellent communication and organizational skills. They will have the ability to work in fast-paced environments and handle dynamic situations in an appropriate manner.

This position requires you to work a total of 12 weeks starting May 29<sup>th</sup>. There will be two weeks of required training followed by 9 weeks of camp then a week for post-camp breakdown. Camp will not be offered during the week of July 3<sup>rd</sup> and counselors will have that week off, without pay.
