*The Carolina Raptor Center ignites a passion for raptors and a responsibility for our shared natural world through raptor rehabilitation, education, and conservation.*

### **Lifesaving Care for Critical Species**

As apex predators, raptors play an essential role in their environment, helping control pest populations and supporting countless other species who share their ecosystem. Our **state-of-the-art Raptor Hospital** is one of the largest in the nation, treating more than 800 sick, injured, and orphaned birds of prey each year. Since our founding in 1981, we have **admitted more than 27,000 patients**, maintaining a goal of successfully releasing them back into the wild.

### **Environmental Education for Generations to Come**

Now more than ever, our communities need reliable, science-based education on conservation and wildlife protection. Raptors are an inspirational force, capable of bringing people together to protect species they love. **Every year, more than 40,000 visitors walk our Raptor Trail**, meeting species of eagles, owls, hawks, falcons, and vultures from around the globe and learning what they can do to protect these amazing creatures. **Our educational programs reach more than 10,000 students annually**, both in their classrooms and at our facility, igniting an excitement for the natural world for generations to come.
